21 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
22 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
23 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
24 and

25 Whereas, Waldo County has certain expenses and
26 liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

27 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the
28 year 1985 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as-
29 sessed in order to provide the required revenue for
30 the county; and

31 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
32 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
33 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
34 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
35 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
36 therefore, be it
