17 AN ACT Concerning the Serving of Liquor for
18 On-premise Consumption in Certain
19 Restaurants.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 28 MRSA §801-D is enacted to read:

24 §801-D. Licenses for restaurants attached to other
25 establishments

26 Licenses for the sale of spirituous, vinous and
27 malt liquor to be consumed on the premises may be is-
28 sued to any restaurant which is attached to, or part
29 of, another retail establishment regardless of the
30 access between the establishments, provided that the
31 license shall restrict the sale of liquor to those
32 hours during which the other retail establishment is
33 closed, provided that access to that other retail es-
34 tablishment by the public is prohibited during those
35 hours. The restaurant must meet all other require-

1 ments for the issuance of the license and shall pay
2 the appropriate fee established for that license un-
3 der this Title.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to permit restaurants
6 which are attached to other retail establishments to
7 obtain a license to sell liquor for on-premise con-
8 sumption during hours when the other retail estab-
9 lishments are closed.

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
