	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §328, as amended by PL 1979, c. 666, §§9 and 10, is repealed and the following en- acted in its place:

1 §328. Administrative rules

The Bureau of Taxation shall promulgate rules es-2 3 tablishing minimum procedures by which the standards 4 set out in section 327 shall be met. Upon a municipal assessing unit's or primary assessing area's failure 5 6 to achieve the minimum assessing standards of this 7 subchapter, the bureau may require additional procedures or practices as necessary corrective steps to 8 9 be undertaken by the municipality, in accordance with 10 sections 291 to 293 and 329.

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The purpose of this bill is to provide that the 13 Bureau of Taxation shall by rule establish minimum 14 assessing procedures and practices which municipali-15 ties must follow in attaining minimum assession stan-16 dards.

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
