The Department of Public Safety and the Division of Motor Vehicles shall study the possibility of establishing a renewal system which requires inspection of motor vehicles to occur in the same month that vehicles are registered. A written report containing findings and recommendations for legislation shall be submitted to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation by December 15, 1985.'

27 28 29 30 31	This amendment instructs the State Police and the Division of Motor Vehicles to conduct a feasibility study to explore the possibility of establishing a renewal system which calls for motor vehicle inspections to occur in the same month as registration.
