COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 391, L.D. 1090, Bill, "AN ACT Making Allocations Related to the Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987."

Amend the bill in section 1 under the caption "EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the last 3 lines (page 2, lines 30, 31 and 32 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
