17 AN ACT to Provide for a Forest

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §9341, as enacted by PL 1979, c.  
23 545, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its  
24 place:

25 §9341. Establishment

26 The Commissioner of Conservation may construct  
27 and maintain public campsites to prevent forest fires  
28 by providing for fire safe sites and by preventing a  
29 proliferation of private fires and to provide recrea-  
30 tional opportunities on public lands and elsewhere in  
31 the state's forests where there is inadequate provi-  
32 sion of private, primitive campsites.
