## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to require that persons found to have permanent handicaps resubmit a physician's certificate every 3 years to verify their continued handicapped status. This is intended to prevent misuse of the plates or placards by members of the handicapped person's family following the death of the handicapped person.
