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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 778, L.D.
1099, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Handicapped Motor Vehicle
Registration Plates or Placards."

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Amend the bill in section 1 in the first line
(page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following
"Sec. 1."

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 19th
line (page 2, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "plates and" and in the 21st line (page 2,
line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
"plates and"

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Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 2

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment removes reference to handicapped
license plates and reinstates language which allows
those with permanent handicaps to maintain their status
without having to submit an annual review by a
physician.
