in the name of the handicapped person or the spouse, parents or legal guardian of the handicapped person, the name of the handicapped person and the date of expiration of the placard. The Secretary of State shall establish by regulation a system of color coding for plates and placards issued pursuant to this section for the purpose of facilitating the determination of validity of plates and placards. When Secretary of State deems it appropriate, a placard may be issued to any handicapped person who does have a duly registered motor vehicle. In such cases the placard may be displayed on any motor vehicle properly registered in this State but it may only be so displayed during the time when the handicapped person is a passenger in the vehicle, when the driver of the vehicle is transporting the handicapped person when the driver is waiting for a service to be rendered to the handicapped person. The annual istration fee is as set forth in this subchapter for the type of vehicle assigned the special designating plates or placard. A \$1 fee shall be charged in those cases where a placard is issued to a handicapped person who does not have a duly registered motor vehicle.

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Sec. 2. 29 MRSA $\S 252$, 3rd \P , as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 16, $\S 2$, is amended to read:

An application under this section shall be accompanied by the certificate of a physician as to that person's physical disability. These persons who are found by their physicians to have permanent handicaps shall not be required to submit annual certificates following their initial qualification:

STATEMENT OF FACT

 The purpose of this bill is to require that certain information be set out on any handicapped placard issued by the Secretary of State. The bill also requires that the Secretary of State color-code plates and placards so that it will be easier to determine their validity.

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
