## STATEMENT OF FACT

9 This bill amends the law pertaining to minimum standards for planting seed potatoes in the State by 10 requiring that all seed planted must have been certi-11 12 fied in accordance with the Department of Agricul-13 ture, Food and Rural Resources. It also changes the 14 penalty for violation of the law from \$20 an acre to 15 minimum of \$20 and a maximum of \$100 an acre and а 16 deletes the need for review of rules prior to adop-17 tion by the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture. 18 Since the program has been operating successfully for 19 several years, the rule-making process, as provided 20 under the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 21 5, chapter 375, is deemed adequate. This bill has no 22 impact on state funding.

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
