18 AN ACT Relating to Initial Plates under the  
19 Motor Vehicle Law.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §192, 3rd ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c.  
24 109, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its  
25 place:

26 Applications for registration plates, as pre-  
27 scribed in this section, pertaining to owners of pas-  
28 senger vehicles or motor vehicles of the station wag-  
29 on type, pickup trucks, motorcycles or camper vehi-  
30 cles, who are residents of this State and who hold a  
31 valid amateur radio station license issued by the  
32 Federal Communications Commission, shall be accompa-  
33 nied by a notarized proof of such license. Registra-  
34 tion plates issued under this paragraph shall be in-  
35 scribed with the official amateur radio call letters  
36 of such applicant as assigned by the Federal Communi-

1 cations Commission. Registration plates so provided  
2 under this paragraph will be issued upon payment of a  
3 one-time service fee of \$20, subsequent  
4 reregistrations will be issued upon payment of a \$5  
5 service fee.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to permit the issu-  
8 ance of registration plates with radio call letters  
9 to licensed radio station operators now provided by  
10 law upon payment of a one-time service fee of \$20  
11 with issuance of subsequent reregistration upon pay-  
12 ment of a \$5 service fee.

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
