The commission shall not award overlapping race dates for extended meets to licensees which are within 50 miles of each other without the approval of 2/3 or more of the entire commission, except that a majority of the commission upon request by the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources may award up to 8 trial overlapping race dates during 1986 following an evaluation by the commissioner of the impact of overlapping race dates.'
