11. Net general assistance costs. "Net general assistance costs" means those direct costs incurred by a municipality in providing assistance to eligible persons according to standards established by the municipal officers and does not include the administrative expenses of the general assistance program, including administrative costs.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

 This bill permits reimbursement of a municipality's administrative costs related to administration of the state-mandated general assistance program. At the present time, administrative costs are specifically excluded from the definition of general assistance costs and are not eligible for state reimbursement. State law does require a substantial administrative commitment from the municipality in order to implement the law. These state-mandated costs are necessary to administer the general assistance program to be eligible for reimbursement.

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
