22	§1056. Appeal of superintendents' decisions
23 24 25 26 27 28	Any decision of a superintendent which is, by law, not subject to the control of the local school board may be appealed to the commissioner on petition of 10% of the number of voters in the last gubernato- rial election in member municipalities of the school administrative unit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides a mechanism for voters of a school unit to appeal decisions of the superintendent which are stautorially beyond the control of the local school board to the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services without initiating the more cumbersome process of having the commissioner inspect the total school program under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, sections 258 and 6801.

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
