COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 799, L.D. 1129, "Resolve, Authorizing the Exchange by the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services of a Certain Parcel of Land in Belfast Fronting on Congress Street and Being Part of the Belfast Armory Lot for Another Parcel of Land to the Rear of Land Adjacent to the Armory with the City of Belfast."

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the Emergency preamble and Emergency clause.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the Emergency preamble and Emergency clause from the resolve in order to be in compliance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 16, which prohibits emergency resolves providing for the sale, transfer or rental of state real estate for a period of 5 years or more.
