18 **Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and**
19 **Authorizing Expenditures of**
20 **Androscoggin County for the Year**

23 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves
24 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
25 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
26 and

27 Whereas, Androscoggin County has certain ex-
28 penses and liabilities which must be met as they be-
29 come due; and

30 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the
31 year 1985 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as-
32 sessed in order to provide the required revenue for
33 the county; and

34 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
35 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
 2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
 3 therefore, be it

5 **Sec. 1. Androscoggin County; taxes apportioned.** Resolved: That the following sum is hereby
 6 granted as a tax on Androscoggin County to be apportioned,
 7 assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts and necessary expenses of the
 8 county as authorized herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar year 1985:

15 **Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.** Resolved: That the following sums, based on
