Appropriation and allocation measures 15 related to section 8. The resources associated with 16 the activities formerly prescribed by the Maine Re-17 vised Statutes, Title 20-A, sections 13005 and 13006 18 shall be reallocated, within the same account, to 19 meet the demands placed on the teacher certification 20 office as a result of enactment of Public Law, 1983, chapter 845. The resources, counsisting of 2 posi-tions currently classified as teacher placement offi-21 22 cer and Clerk Stenographer II, shall be classified as 23 Education Specialist I and Clerk Stenographer II. 24 25 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-26 tions to read consecutively 27 STATEMENT OF FACT 28 The purposes of this amendment are to delete from 29 the bill 2 sections which have been enacted in anoth-30 er bill this session and to reallocate resources of 31 the Department of Educational and Cultural Services. 20 3660051485
