COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 801, L.D. 1135, Bill, "AN ACT to Update and Improve the Education Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 5 and 6

Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 11. Appropriation and allocation measures related to section 8. The resources associated with the activities formerly prescribed by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, sections 13005 and 13006 shall be reallocated, within the same account, to meet the demands placed on the teacher certification office as a result of enactment of Public Law, 1983, chapter 845. The resources, consisting of 2 positions currently classified as teacher placement officer and Clerk Stenographer II, shall be classified as Education Specialist I and Clerk Stenographer II.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purposes of this amendment are to delete from the bill 2 sections which have been enacted in another bill this session and to reallocate resources of the Department of Educational and Cultural Services.

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
