1. Application. A person eligible to receive or  
holding a state teacher's certificate, may register

The original bill would have eliminated the teacher placement program in the Department of Educational and Cultural Services. That program is still functioning and provides a useful service to many teachers and school units each year. This amendment would continue the program and increase the fee to teachers registering for placement from \$5 to \$35.


