3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 4 follows:

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P&SL 1903, c. 369, §2 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 2. May acquire lands for free public uses. 7 Said The corporation shall be a nonprofit historical 8 society, and shall have power to acquire, by devise, 9 gift or purchase, and to own, arrange, hold, maintain 10 and improve, for free public use, lands in Hancock 11 County, Maine, which by reason of scenic beauty, his-12 torical interest, sanitary advantages, or for other 13 reasons, may be available for the purpose.

14 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 15 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-16 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The purpose of this bill is to amend the powers 19 of the Hancock County Trustees of Public Reservations 20 to enable the corporation to become a nonprofit his-21 torical society.

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
