17 AN ACT Relating to the Extension of Benefits
18 by Participating Districts under the
19 Maine State Retirement System.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 5 MRSA §1092, sub-§12-B is enacted to read:

24 12-B. Disability benefits for policemen and
25 firefighters. Notwithstanding any other provision of
26 this section, a participating local district may
27 adopt the disability retirement benefits enacted by
28 Public Law 1975, chapter 622, section 54, for police-
29 men and firefighters employed by the local district
30 without being required to adopt those benefits for
31 other employees of the district.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit local par-
3 ticipating districts under the state retirement law
4 to adopt disability benefits offered under state law
5 for policemen and firefighters without having to
6 adopt those same benefits for other employees of the
7 district.

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
