17 AN ACT To Provide Penalties for Violations of  
18 Antitrust Statutes.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 10 MRSA §1104, as amended by PL 1983, c. 340, §2,  
23 is further amended to read:

24 §1104. Right of action, damages and civil penalties

25 Any person, including the State or any political  
26 subdivision thereof, injured in its business or prop-  
27 erty by any other person or corporation by reason of  
28 anything forbidden or declared to be unlawful by sec-  
29 tions 1101 and 1102 or section 1102-A, may sue there-  
30 for in a civil action and shall recover 3-fold the  
31 damages sustained and costs of suit, including neces-  
32 sary and reasonable investigative costs, reasonable  
33 expert's fees and a reasonable attorney fee.
