## 4 STATEMENT OF FACT

- 5 This amendment makes the following changes in the 6 bill:
- 7 1. Removes the sentence that would provide that 8 the rights under the bill go with the vehicle to a subsequent transferee;
- 2. Returns the standard for replacement of a motor vehicle to the standard used in the current law;
- 3. Instead of incidental damages, the refund would provide for the consumer's recovery of the costs of the towing, vehicle storage and alternate transportation;
- 16 4. Corrects a technical error in numbering; and
- 17 5. Provides that a violation of this chapter is 18 prima facie evidence of an unfair trade practice, 19 rather than being itself an unfair trade practice.
