COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 820, L.D.
1161, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Coverage of Certain
Trials by the Electronic Media."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §119 is enacted to read:

§119. Media coverage of judicial proceedings

The taking of photographs or radio or television
broadcasting or transmitting of judicial proceedings
in the Superior Court shall be permitted upon the
promulgation of and in accordance with rules adopted
by the Supreme Judicial Court.

This section is repealed on November 1, 1987.

Sec. 2. 4 MRSA §182 is enacted to read:

§182. Media coverage of judicial proceedings

The taking of photographs or radio or television
broadcasting or transmitting of judicial proceedings
in the District Court shall be permitted upon the
promulgation of and in accordance with rules adopted
by the Supreme Judicial Court.

This section is repealed on November 1, 1987.'
