22 Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §119 is enacted to read:

23 §119. Media coverage of judicial proceedings

24 The taking of photographs in a Superior Court
25 room or radio or television broadcasting or transmit-
26 ting of judicial proceedings from any such court room
27 during the progress of judicial proceedings or any
28 recess of judicial proceedings shall be permitted by
29 the court when all parties to the proceedings agree
30 to the photographing, broadcasting or transmitting of
31 those proceedings.
