L2 L3	The court, in ordering restitution for any crime under chapter 15, may order any motor vehicle, as defined in section 363, owned by an offender, which was used to facilitate the commission of any crime under chapter 15, sold for the purposes of providing funds for that restitution. The proceeds of any such sale shall also be used to pay the expenses of the sale and to pay any bona fide holder of a security interest in the motor vehicle.

- 1. Provide for the sale of a motor vehicle, including a motor driven cycle, snowmobile or an all-terrain vehicle used in the commission of a theft crime in order to make restitution to the victim; and
- 2. Provide that any person convicted of a theft 22 crime committed with a motor vehicle shall lose their 23 operators license for one year.
