Whereas, Acts of the Legis-13 lature do not become effective until 90 days 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 1.5 Whereas, the Department of Conservation is developing a pilot vehicle rental project which would ap-16 17 ply to other agencies of State Government; and 18 Whereas, this pilot project will be subject to sunset provision of July 1, 1987, unless reenacted by 19 the Legislature; and 20 2.1 Whereas, the results of the pilot rental project 22 may be more easily calculated in accordance with the 23 fiscal year of State Government; and 24 Whereas, the fiscal year begins on July 1, which 25 occurs prior to the effective date of legislation en-26 acted during the First Regular Session of the 112th 27 Legislature; and 28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 29 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 30 the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 31 32 33 therefore, ' 34 Further amend the bill by adding before the 35 Statement of Fact the following:

1	§5032. Termination date
2	This chapter shall be repealed on July 1, 1987, unless reenacted by the Legislature.
4 5 6	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1985.'
7	STATEMENT OF FACT
8 9 10 11 12	The purpose of this amendment is to allow the Department of Conservation to initiate operation of the agency on July 1, 1985, which will allow the results of the project to be measured consistent with the fiscal years of State Government.
13 14 15	This amendment also provides a 2-year sunset date for the operation of the pilot vehicle rental agency. The "pilot" agency will terminate on July 1, 1987.
