to H.P. 837, L.D. 1181, Bill, "AN ACT to Strengthen

Further amend the amendment by striking out all
of section 8 and inserting in its place the follow-
ing:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.


