COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 425, L.D. 1182, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$3,000,000 for Acquisition and Development of State Parks, Historic and River Access Sites."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$2,750,000 for Acquisition and Development of State Parks, Historic Sites and Protective Easements for Maine Rivers.'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in the 7th line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the figure "\$3,000,000" and inserting in its place the figure '\$2,750,000'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in the 5th line from the end (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the figure "20" and inserting in its place the figure '5'

Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking out all of the 10th line (page 3, line 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Three Brooks Cove - Cross Lake 330,000'

Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking out all of the last 2 lines (page 3, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Protective Easement for Maine Rivers 250,000
