IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
AN ACT Concerning Inspection of Boarding Care Facilities.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>22 MRSA §7902, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1977, c. 497, §4, is further amended to read:</pre>
§7902. Rules
1. <u>Rules promulgated</u> . The commissioner shall promulgate rules for boarding care facilities, which shall include but need not be limited to rules per- taining to administration, staffing, the number of residents, the quality of care, the quality of treat- ment, if applicable, the health and safety of staff and residents, the rights of residents, community re- lations, the administration of medication and licens- ing procedures.

1 These rules shall include rules requiring, at a mini-2 mum, annual inspection of boarding care facilities by 3 the department to insure that the quality of care and 4 treatment of residents in the facilities is adequate.

5 establishing the rules for the administration of In 6 medication, the commissioner shall consider, among 7 other factors, the general health of the persons 8 likely to receive medication, the number of persons served by the facility and the number of persons em-9 ployed by the facility. In the rules for the adminis-10 tration of medication established for boarding care 11 12 facilities with 15 or more residents, the Department 13 of Human Services shall require unlicensed personnel to have successfully completed a program of training 14 and instruction for the administration of medication 15 16 which is not limited to in-service training.
