1 These funds are to be 2 made available to the Re-3 gional Agriculture Com-4 mittee which was created in Resolves 1983, chapter 5 6 46. Funds for personal 7 services will provide the 8 opportunity to hire a 1/2 9 time project coordinator 10 who will staff the Re-11 gional Agriculture Com-12 mittee and work with oth-13 er state and provincial 14 committees to develop and 15 support regional 16 projects. The project 17 position will end with of the 18 the termination 19 1986-87 fiscal year. 20 Funds in the all other 21 category include \$2,000 22 in each year for 23 and expenses and the re-24 mainder is to be used 25 matching funds to initi-26 ate and sustain activi-27 ties which benefit the 28 states of New England and 29 Quebec and the Maritimes.

In the last legislative session, the Legislature approved the establishment of a Regional Agriculture Committee which has been working to promote the effective utilization of shared resources between states and provinces for the purpose of addressing common goals in the field of agriculture. These funds requested will provide the opportunity to hire a part-time project coordinator and the financial resources to match grants from other cooperating jurisdictions and private institutions. Cooperative ventures that might be worthy of financial support include research and demonstration work in technology transfer, telecommunications, educational television programming and regional marketing strategies.
