In determining eligibility under this chapter and chapter 905 for persons not currently receiving benefits under chapter 905, the cost of any drugs of a type which are covered under the provisions of the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program, purchased by the plicant during the year for which income is being calculated, shall be deducted from the applicant's income. In determining eligibility under this chapter and chapter 905 for persons receiving benefits under chapter 905, the fair market value of any drugs covered under the provisions of the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program, procured by the applicant during year for which income is being calculated, shall be deducted from the applicant's income. The Commissioner of Human Services shall, by rule, establish procedures for calculating the fair market value of drugs pursuant to this subsection.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend the eligibility requirements for the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program and the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act to deduct the costs of drugs covered under the program from an applicant's income when determining eligibility for the program. Once a person becomes eligible for the program, the fair market value of drugs procured through the program would be deducted from his income in determining his continued eligibility for the program. This will prevent the situation of a person becoming ineligible for continued benefits simply because of the money saved by the individual in procuring drugs through the program.
