- 2. Kindergarten. "Kindergarten" means kindergarten, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 15.
- 3. Nursery school. "Nursery school" means nursery school, as defined in Title 22, section 8401.

§2872. Fingerprints required

No person may be employed in any day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or public or private
elementary or secondary school, unless prior to commencement of that employment the person furnishes to
the day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten
or school a complete set of fingerprints taken by an
authorized law enforcement officer.

The day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or school shall retain a copy of any employee's fingerprints submitted pursuant to section 2872, for the duration of that employee's employment, and shall forward a copy of any such fingerprints to the Chief of the State Police.

Sec. 2. Transition. Any person employed in a day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or public or private elementary or secondary school on the effective date of this Act shall, within 90 days, furnish to the day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or school a complete set of fingerprints which shall be processed in accordance with this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that all employees of day care facilities, nursery schools, kindergartens and elementary or secondary schools be fingerprinted.
