8	STATEMENT OF FACT

9 Some licensees carry on the activities in more 10 than one location, within or without a single 11 premise, all under the direction and management of а 12 single person. At the present time, each separate 13 location must maintain a separate liquor license imposing a significant financial 14 and administrative 15 burden on both the licensee and the commission. The 16 purpose of this bill is to provide a means by which a 17 single license can be established to cover more than 18 one location under specific restrictions and guide-19 lines so as to be consistent with the purposes of the 20 liquor licensing law.

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
