The circumstances surrounding that individual's disappearance indicate that the in-1 2 3 dividual may possibly have been removed by another from the control of the individual's legal 4 5 custodian without the custodian's consent; or 6 B. The circumstances of the case strongly indi-7 cate that the individual is likely to be abused 8 or sexually exploited. 9 2. Report. Any local, county or state law enforcement agency receiving a report of a missing 10 11 child within the State shall send to the United States Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinguency 12 13 Prevention, as soon as practicable, a report concern-14 ing that missing child, including any information 15 which might be useful in locating or identifying that 16 missing child.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The purpose of this bill is to require that 10-19 cal, county and state law enforcement agencies report 20 cases of missing children to the United States Office 21 of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention which maintains a national clearinghouse for information on 22 23 missing children. The report would include all in-24 formation available which might be helpful in locat-25 ing or identifying the missing children.
