17 18 19	AN ACT to Require Sufficient Notification in Cases of Adoption of Agency Rules.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	5 MRSA §8053-A is enacted to read:
23	§8053-A. Notification of adoption of rule
24 25 26 27 28	Upon the adoption of any rule, except an emergen- cy rule adopted pursuant to section 8054, an agency shall delay implementation of the rule for 30 days from the date of adoption. During that 30-day peri- od, the agency shall:
29 30	1. Publication. Publish a notice of the adoption of the rule and an explanation of the rule:
31 32	A. In a newspaper of general circulation in each area of the State affected by the rule; and

- 1B. In any other trade, industry, professional or2interest group publication which the agency deems3effective in reaching persons affected; and
- 4 <u>2. Notice. Notify:</u>
- A. Any person specified by the law authorizing
 the rulemaking; and
- B. Any person who has filed within the past year
 a written request with the agency for notice of
 rulemaking. Notification under this paragraph
 shall be by mail or otherwise in writing to the
 last address provided to the agency by that person.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to provide a 30-day 15 notice period prior to the implementation of any 16 agency rule. During this period, the agency will no-17 tify those affected by the rule so that they might 18 comply with its provisions.
