17 AN ACT Relating to Regulation Fees Under the
18 Manufacturing of Bedding, Upholstered
19 Furniture and Cushion Law.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 26 MRSA §111, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1973, c.
24 555, §1, is further amended to read:

25 Any individually owned business in this State
26 manufacturing cushions, ~~as described~~ defined in sec-
27 tion 81, subsection 3, or articles of bedding, as de-
28 defined in section 81, subsection 1, and whose gross
29 income from the sale of these products is under
30 \$1,500 per year, shall register with the bureau on
31 forms provided by the bureau, that set forth those
32 items covered in this section. A fee of \$5 shall ac-
33 company each registration. This registration shall be
34 valid for a period of one year and the individuals
35 will be subject to all other requirements of this
36 chapter.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to afford manufacturers of articles of bedding whose gross annual income from their sale is less than \$1,500 the same registration fee as certain manufacturers of cushions.

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
