dent of the Senate; 2 members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of House of Representatives; one member of the Committee Judicial Responsibility and Disability to be designated by that committee; the Chief Justice of Supreme Judicial Court or his designee; 2 members of public to be appointed by the President of the ate; and 2 public members to be appointed by the Senate: Speaker of the House of Representatives. The commis-sion shall select its chairman from among its members; and be it further 

Subject of study. Resolved: That the commission shall study the legislative powers of impeachment and address, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. The provisions contained in the Constitution of Maine providing for removal of civil and judicial officers of the State from office by the address of the Legislature;
- 20 2. The decisions of the Supreme Judicial Court 21 as they pertain to those constitutional provisions; 22 and
  - 3. Laws and rules of procedure used by the United States Congress and other states in implementing their constitutional powers of impeachment and removal by address; and be it further

Report on findings and recommendations. Resolved: That the commission shall complete its study and report its findings and recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation on or before January 1, 1986, to the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. This report shall address each of the matters set forth in this resolve and shall include proposed legislation in proper draft form to be enacted by the Legislature to effectuate the course of action the commission recommends; and be it further

Professional assistance. Resolved: That the commission may employ such professional staff and consultants as it deems necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolve; and be it further

1	Compensation. Resolved: That all members of the
2	commission who are not state employees or Legislators
