17 **Resolve, Authorizing a Study Concerning**
18 **Extension of the Maine Turnpike.**

20 **Extension of turnpike; study. Resolved:** That
21 the Department of Transportation shall conduct a
22 study of the feasibility and desirability of extend-
23 ing the present Maine Turnpike from Kennebunk, Saco
24 or Wells west to Sanford and on to the New Hampshire
25 Turnpike at Rochester. This study shall also include
26 the feasibility and desirability of adding a 3rd lane
27 to the turnpike from Wells to Portland. The depart-
28 ment shall report its findings, together with any im-
29 plementing legislation, to the Second Regular Session
30 of the 112th Legislature.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this resolve is to require the Department of Transportation to conduct a study concerning the feasibility of extending the Maine Turnpike from Kennebunk, Saco or Wells west to Sanford and on to the New Hampshire Turnpike at Rochester. This study shall also include the feasibility of adding a 3rd lane to the turnpike from Wells to Portland.

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
