"Rust-proofing" means 1 any 2 procedure or method involving the application to all 3 or any portion of the body of a motor vehicle of a product designed specifically to prevent, retard, de-4 5 lay or deter the development of rust on that vehicle. 6 §1192. Rustproofing warranties; liability 7 Any person offering any express warranties con-8 cerning the rust-proofing of any motor vehicle shall be liable for any damage resulting to that motor ve-9 hicle as a result of the failure of the rust-proofing 10 11 to conform to those express warranties. The liabili-12 ty imposed by this section is in addition to any oth-13 er liability imposed by law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is to provide that when 16 a person rust-proofs a motor vehicle and makes ex-17 press warranties concerning that rust-proofing he 18 shall be liable for any damages resulting to the mo-19 tor vehicle as a result of the breach of those ex-20 press warranties.
