The purpose of this bill is to make it clear that persons who exercise control over or knowingly possess writings which may be maintained in electronic storage devices such as computer disks or other media may now be prosecuted for a form of theft by unauthorized use, a Class D crime. For example, a person who is not authorized who managed to gain access to a police department's records storage system and who obtained an electronically stored copy of a report or other writing, would be guilty under this section. By way of comparison, a person who broke into lice department and took a police report which was printed on paper, could be charged with burglary. This bill recognizes the need to protect against unauthorized access to writings which are electronically or otherwise stored.
