AN ACT to Ensure Affordable Telephone Costs
for Nonprofit Social Service Corporations by Prohibiting the Local
Measured Service Rate Structure for these Customers.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
35 MRSA §107 is enacted to read:
§107. Mandatory measured service; social service or-
ganizations
1. Measured service for social service organizations prohibited. No telephone company which imple-
ments mandatory measuring of local telephone calls
may apply that measuring to a social service organization or to any satellite telephone line of that or-
ganization. Any social service organization which
uses satellite telephone lines shall file an affida-

- 1 mission, with the telephone company identifying any 2 satellite telephone line used within the organization.
  - 2. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
    - A. "Satellite telephone line" means a telephone line used by an employee or volunteer of a social service organization located other than at the offices of the organization.
    - B. "Social service organization" means any not-for-profit corporation, association or organization which provides counseling, medical, referral or emergency services, including, but not limited to, mental health, health assistance, rescue, police, fire and other related emergency services, suicide prevention, substance abuse counselling, run-away hotlines, domestic violence or abuse or neglect.

## 20 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit local measured telephone service for social service organizations which provide emergency-type services.
