Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §852, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c. 541, Pt. A, §187, is further amended to read:

4 No licensee for the sale of liquor to be consumed 5 licensed premises, except in Class A restaurants, on 6 Class A taverns, clubs and hotel dining rooms, shall 7 may employ any person under the age of 18 years legal 8 drinking age as provided in this Title in the direct handling or selling of liquor on the premises where 9 10 such the liquor is sold. No licensee for the sale of 11 liquor to be consumed on the licensed premises of 12 Class A restaurants, Class A taverns, clubs and hotel 13 dining rooms shall may employ any person under the age of 17 years in the direct handling or selling of 14 liquor on the premises where such the liquor is sold, 15 unless provided that in any event an employee who is 16 17 18 years of age of legal drinking age as provided in 18 this Title or older is present in a supervisory ca-19 pacity.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this new draft is to insure that 3 the sale of liquor for consumption on the premises 4 takes place only when someone of legal drinking age 5 is present in a responsible capacity.

6 Section 3 of the new draft repeals the "sunset" 7 provision which applies to licenses to sell beer and 8 wine at outdoor stadiums. Although other facilities 9 may be licensed in the future, the only one which 10 qualifies at this time is the Maine Guides Stadium, The Ball Park in Old Orchard Beach. The Bureau of Li-11 12 quor Enforcement conducted several inspections of the 13 facility and conferred with local enforcement agen-14 They are satisfied that the stadium operators cies. 15 are complying fully with the law and recommend that the provision repealing the outdoor stadium license 16 17 in September be repealed. This new draft makes Public 18 Law 1983, chapter 755 permanent.
