At the present time, the additional costs to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services, the Department of Corrections and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, together, will be approximately \$5,000,000.
22	STATEMENT OF FACT
23 24 25 26	The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that if insufficient state funds are not appropriated to pay all costs involved, the local school unit shall pick up the excess costs, as they do now, and that

if insufficient state funds are not appropriated to pay all costs involved, the local school unit shall pick up the excess costs, as they do now, and that those excess costs will be included as special education costs under the School Finance Act. The amendment also deletes the emergency preamble and the emergency clause, makes 2 technical corrections, provides for an effective date of July 1, 1987 and adds a fiscal note for potential future costs.
