 Sec. 3. 1 MRSA §1013, sub-§2, ¶B-1 is enacted to read:

B-1. A Legislator making a complaint pursuant to subsection 1, paragraph D, shall file the complaint under oath with the chairman. The complaint shall specify the facts of the alleged improper ruling or decision. Upon a majority vote of the commission, the commission shall conduct such investigation and shall hold such hearings as its deems necessary. The commission shall issue its findings of fact together with its opinion to the House of which the Legislator making the complaint is a member. That House may take whatever action it deems appropriate, in accordance with the Constitution of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow Legislators to file complaints with the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices concerning nonparliamentary rulings or decisions of the President of the Senate or Speaker of the House of Representatives concerning conduct or activities of Legislators.
