	AN ACT Concerning Motor Vehicle Insurance and the Household Exclusion.
	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	24-A MRSA §2902-A is enacted to read:
	§2902-A. Household exclusion
	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
	A. "Family member" means a person related to the insured by blood, marriage or adoption who is a resident of the insured's household, including a ward or foster child.
	2. Exclusion. No insurer may sell or renew an insurance policy providing motor vehicle liability

1	insurance on or after January 1, 1986, that excludes
2	coverage for injuries sustained by the insured's fam-
3	ily members unless the insurer notifies the bureau in
4	writing of its utilization of the exclusion, the in-
5	surer notifies each of its licensed agents within the
6	State of its utilization of the exclusion and the ex-
7	clusion is provided by a separate endorsement to the
8	insured's policy. An exclusion that does not meet
9	the requirements of this section shall be invalid and
10	of no effect.

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 Under this new draft, an insurer may not exclude 13 members of the insured's family from motor vehicle 14 liability coverage unless the insurer notifies the 15 Bureau of Insurance and the insurer's agents that it 16 is offering the exclusion in its policies and the ex-17 clusion is done by a separate endorsement to the pol-18 icy so that the insured is aware of the exclusion.
