Amend the bill by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to
Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of
\$15,000,000 for Sewage Treatment, Water Quality Im-
provement Facilities and Restoration and Cleanup of
Oil Contaminated Ground Water and Well Water.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking
out all of the first sentence (page 1, lines 30 to 31
in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
'Authorization of bonds to provide for sewage treat-
ment, water quality improvement facilities and resto-
ration and cleanup of the State's ground water and
well water.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 3rd
line from the end (page 2, line 6 in L.D.) by insert-
ing after the following: "bonds." the following: 'The
Treasurer of State is further authorized, under the
direction of the Governor, to issue from time to time
registered bonds in the name and behalf of the State
to an amount not exceeding \$3,000,000 for the purpose
of raising funds to provide for the cleanup and res-
toration of oil contaminated ground water and well
water. The bonds shall be deemed a pledge of the full
faith and credit of the State. The bonds shall not
run for a longer period than 5 years from the date of
the original issue of the bonds.'
