COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " 7 " to H.P. 907, L.D. 1306, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$12,000,000 for Sewage Treatment and Water Quality Improvement Facilities."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$15,000,000 for Sewage Treatment, Water Quality Improvement Facilities and Restoration and Cleanup of Oil Contaminated Ground Water and Well Water.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first sentence (page 1, lines 30 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Authorization of bonds to provide for sewage treatment, water quality improvement facilities and restoration and cleanup of the State's ground water and well water.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "bonds." the following: 'The Treasurer of State is further authorized, under the direction of the Governor, to issue from time to time registered bonds in the name and behalf of the State to an amount not exceeding \$3,000,000 for the purpose of raising funds to provide for the cleanup and restoration of oil contaminated ground water and well water. The bonds shall be deemed a pledge of the full faith and credit of the State. The bonds shall not run for a longer period than 5 years from the date of the original issue of the bonds.'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (page 2, lines 37 and 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "State Direc-
