17 Resolve, Creating a Commission to Study Age
18 Discrimination in Employment.

20 Study commission created. Resolved: That there
21 is created the Commission to Study Age Discrimination
22 in Employment; and be it further

23 Appointment. Resolved: That the commission
24 shall consist of 11 members, as follows: Two Senators
25 appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 Represent-
26 natives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Rep-
27 resentatives; the Director of the Bureau of Maine's
28 Elderly, or his designee; the Director of the Maine
29 Committee on Aging or his designee; and one member
30 from each of the 5 regional area agencies on aging,
31 to be appointed by the Governor. The commission
32 shall choose a chairman from among its members; and
33 be it further

34 Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall un-
35 dertake a complete study of the statistics and per-

1 suasive patterns of employment of older adults in the
2 public sector and consider methods to overcome any ex-
3 isting age discrimination in public sector employ-
4 ment; and be it further

5 **Compensation. Resolved:** That members of the com-
6 mission shall not receive any compensation, but shall
7 be reimbursed for all necessary expenses; and be it
8 further

9 **Reports. Resolved:** That the commission shall
10 present its findings, together with any recommended
11 legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the
12 112th Legislature.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT
