20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 7 MRSA §194-A is enacted to read:

23 §194-A. Salary levels of cooperative extension cler-
24 ical staff personnel

25 The salary levels for cooperative extension cler-
26 ical staff personnel within a county shall be estab-
27 lished by the executive committee of the county ex-
28 ension association for that county. The University
29 of Maine may augment any salary established pursuant
30 to this section.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to provide that the salary levels for cooperative extension clerical personnel shall be set by the county executive committee rather than by the University of Maine. The bill allows the University of Maine to augment those salaries if it wishes.

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
